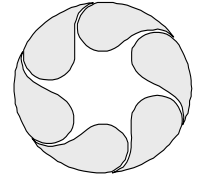

### November's Program

At November's program portrait photographer **Casey Gorman** treated CCB members to an outstanding presentation. **Casey** demonstrated several methods of lighting for portrait photography. The butterfly lighting is one that is similar to that used in glamour photography. Here the light is placed high until you see a "butterfly" on the top lip of the subject. The

Rembrandt lighting creates a triangle of shadow on the cheek. Here the light is placed up and slightly behind the subject. Broad lighting is accomplished by placing the light to the side of the subject closest to the camera. It is used for people with a thin face. Short lighting is setup by applying light to the side of the face that is away from the camera.

He also shared some of his solutions to problem portraits. Generally if you are beginning, **Casey** suggests using one light and a reflector placed on the opposite side of the subject to lighten the shadows. If you use a two light setup, take an exposure reading for each light separately and set the lights so there is a 1 *f*-stop difference between them. He suggests a slight underexposure when shooting digital or slides. **Casey** uses a 70 to 105 mm when shooting with a film camera or a 35 to 50 mm when shooting digital. He sets his exposure for the highlights when shooting digital and for the shadows when shooting film.
