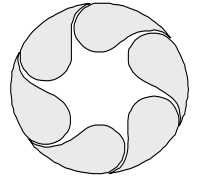

Helpful Hints - *Richard Thomson*

Aperture-priority (Av) mode

When using aperture-priority, also known as Av mode, you manually select the aperture and the camera automatically sets the shutter speed. The aperture is the opening in a lens that admits light onto the camera sensor and is varied by changing the size of the opening. It's diameter is stated as an f-stop. Aperture-priority mode is used when you want to control depth-of-field.

Shutter-priority (Tv) mode

Shutter speed relates to how long the camera's shutter stays open after you depress the shutter-release button. Shutter speed is measured in seconds, such as 1/125th. A slow shutter speed produces a longer exposure time. For shutter-priority mode (Tv), select the shutter speed and the aperture adjusts automatically. Use shutter-priority mode when you want to control action in a photo either to freeze the action of fast moving subjects or to create a sense of movement.
